In regards to planting on private property, we have received no guidance from any regulatory government agency on whether planting is safe.

The Rutgers New Jersey Agricultural Experiment Station (NJAES) Cooperative Extension can test soil for a fee. The Borough is not endorsing them but it is an option if you are interested in having your ground tested.
