

Hurricane Sandy Information

There are currently no watches or warnings issued for Bergen County.

Current forecast data shows that Hurricane Sandy has lessened to a Category 1 storm with sustained winds of 80 MPH moving north at 6MPH. Sandy is approximately 460 miles SSE of Charleston, South Carolina.

There is still uncertainty with the exact track at this time, however current prediction models call for land fall to be south and west of New Jersey near Delaware-Maryland around 0200 hrs on Tuesday.

Sandy could bring between 3-5 inches of rain, tropical storm force winds, and significant flooding to us through Wednesday (10/31). Sandy is interacting with other systems which will slow its departure from our area.

There is a full-moon Sunday (10/28) which will

increase the potential for tidal flooding.

The Bergen County EOC will be activated at 0600 hours on Monday (10/29).


