**This is a list of some things the court staff can and cannot do for you.
Please read it carefully before asking the court staff for help.**

WE CAN

- explain and answer questions about how the court works.
- tell you what the requirements are to have your case considered by the court.
- give you some information from your case file.
- provide you with samples of court forms that are available.
- provide you with guidance on how to fill out forms.
- usually answer questions about court deadlines.

WE CANNOT

- give you legal advice. Only your lawyer can give you legal advice.
- tell you whether or not you should bring your case to court.
- give you an opinion about what will happen if you bring your case to court.
- recommend a lawyer, but we can provide you with the telephone number of a local lawyer referral service.
- talk to the judge for you about what will happen in your case.
- let you talk to the judge outside of court.
- change an order issued by a judge.
